EXCEL SHEETS PASSWORD RECOVERY

1. INTRODUCTION

The sheets used on Excel can be blocked by the users in order to avoid that the sheet can be modified without keeping control on the changes or by mistake.

Excel provides the security of unblocking the sheet only if a password is known. When this option is used, the user losses access to modify the cells.

If the password is forgotten the functionality of the sheet can be completely lost. The current method explains how to unblock a sheet previously blocked with a password.

2. UNBLOCKING SHEETS

The way to unblock a sheet previously blocked with a password is to create a macro under the current sheet and write (copy and paste) the following code:
